## Club Stickers and High Viz Socks



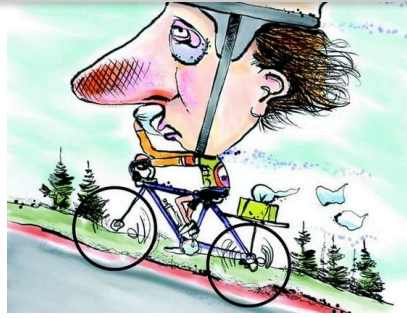
SFCC has purchased club stickers that are free to all SFCC members. These are custom made with the SFCC logo on them and are approximately 5" x 3.25"
